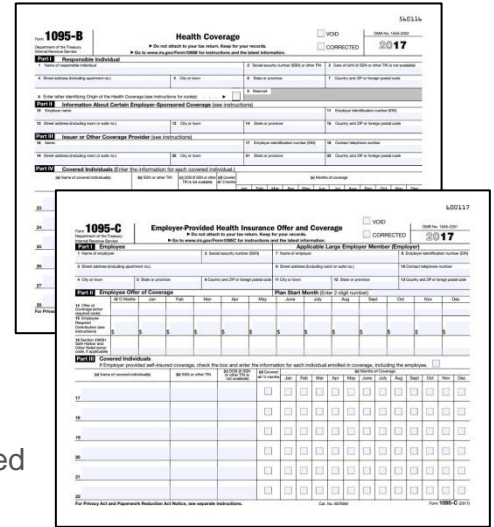


# COMING SOON: TAX FORMS REGARDING YOUR HEALTH COVERAGE

In compliance with the Affordable Care Act (ACA), the City of Los Angeles will provide Internal Revenue Service (IRS) **Form 1095-C** to employees that received an offer of health insurance coverage during the 2017 calendar year.

Individuals who obtained health insurance in 2017 will also receive IRS **Form 1095-B** from their health insurance carrier. Form 1095-B does not come from the City. Additional information regarding Forms 1095-B and 1095-C is provided on the inside of this mailer.

**Form 1095-C will be mailed to your home address on file no later than March 2, 2018.** Per the Internal Revenue Service, you are not required to attach Form 1095-C to your tax return. Form 1095-C is used for your information and for your tax records. Please see additional information at: <https://www.irs.gov/affordable-care-act>.



## FORM 1095-C (From Employer)

### What is this form?

Form 1095-C provides information about a health insurance **offer** made to an employee by their employer.





## FORM 1095-B (From Health Insurance Carrier)

### What is this form?

Form 1095-B provides information about the health insurance **coverage** an individual, *and dependents*, received from a health insurance carrier.





### Who do I contact if I think there is an error on my Form 1095-B?

A contact phone number is provided in Box 18 of Form 1095-B. The City does not provide Form 1095-B. Please direct requests for corrections to your health insurance carrier.

### Who do I contact if I did not receive my Form 1095-B?

Form 1095-B comes from your health insurance carrier. If you are a member of plans offered by a sworn Police/Fire association, please contact the health insurance carrier you had in 2017. For civilian employees who obtained health insurance in 2017 from a LAwell Benefits Program health insurance carrier, please contact the appropriate carrier at one of the following phone numbers:
