The City of Los Angeles offers a comprehensive vision benefits plan for your eye care needs contracted with EyeMed Vision Care.

The plan covers:

- Eye exams
- Prescription eyewear (eyeglasses or contact lenses)

A schedule of covered benefits and added discounts is available to you; your responsibility is:

- Copays
- Balances that exceed allowances and
- Non-covered options available at discounted fees



What services are covered?

- ❑ Comprehensive eye exam which includes eye health testing and evaluation for prescription eyewear, including:
 - Dilation
 - Eye drops that widen pupils to give your provider a better view of the back of the eye
 - Retinal imaging
 - A digital image of the inside of the eye that tracks eye health conditions for year over year comparison
- ❑ Contact Lens fit & follow up
 - Additional evaluation to determine a patient's suitability for contact lenses or a contact lens prescription change
